#### **Psalm 76:1-12 New International Version**

<sup>1</sup> God is renowned in Judah; in Israel his name is great.

<sup>2</sup> His tent is in Salem, his dwelling place in Zion.

- <sup>3</sup> There he broke the flashing arrows,  
the shields and the swords, the weapons of war.
- <sup>4</sup> You are radiant with light, more majestic than mountains rich with game.
- <sup>5</sup> The valiant lie plundered, they sleep their last sleep;  
not one of the warriors can lift his hands.
- <sup>6</sup> At your rebuke, God of Jacob, both horse and chariot lie still.
- <sup>7</sup> It is you alone who are to be feared.  
Who can stand before you when you are angry?
- <sup>8</sup> From heaven you pronounced judgment,  
and the land feared and was quiet—
- <sup>9</sup> when you, God, rose up to judge, to save all the afflicted of the land.
- <sup>10</sup> Surely your wrath against mankind brings you praise,  
and the survivors of your wrath are restrained.<sup>[c]</sup>
- <sup>11</sup> Make vows to the LORD your God and fulfill them; let all the neighboring lands
